1 – What are different ways you see the Lord's compassion demonstrated throughout the Bible?

2 – How has the Lord demonstrated His compassion towards you?

3 – Here are some questions to help you think through your own practice of forgiveness:

Is there anyone you have refused to forgive when they have asked for your forgiveness?

Is there someone you have not truly forgiven?

- Do you still hold them personally guilty for the offense?
- Do you still hold that offense against them?
- Do you still bring up the offense to them?
- Do you remind them of that offense?
- Do you still bring up their offense to others?
- Do you choose to think about and to meditate on and to consider their sin and the hurt that it was to you?
- Do you still want some measure of personal revenge?
- Do you want them to suffer, at least some, for how much they made you suffer?

If you had to answer yes to any of those questions, then it is very possible that you have not truly forgiven that person.
