

Banner (Team of 2 Members)

Description

The NYC SkillsUSA Banner (Team of 2 Members) contest is developed for students to create a banner that is New York and SkillsUSA. The banner must be accompanied with supporting documentation and an oral presentation must be given.

Clothing Requirements

- NYC SkillsUSA T-Shirt
- Black dress slacks accompanied by black dress socks or black or skin tones seamless hose) or black dress skirt (knee- length, accompanied by black or skin- tone seamless hose).
- Black shoes that are not backless or open toe.

Equipment and Materials

1. **Supplied by NYC chair/committee:**
 - a. Equipment needed to display banners.
 - b. All information necessary for the contestants and evaluators
2. **Supplied by contestant:**
 - a. The banner
 - i. Attachments, such as grommets, rod pocket and rod, or other means, used or needed to hang banners on supplied pipes.
 - b. Required notebook and information
 - c. All competitors must create a one-page resume.

Scope of the Competition

The contest is designed to assess the ability of the competitors to design and produce a banner that clearly stands for SkillsUSA and New York. It also evaluates members' abilities to give a presentation and to prepare a notebook about the creation of the banner.

BANNER

1. The banner and notebook must be brought between 3 and 8 pm on the day of the orientation meeting.
2. Entries will be limited to one per chapter.
3. Banner maximum size is 60" in length and 36" in height. Minimum size is 48" in length and 24" in height.
4. The banner may be constructed of any material. Added three-dimensional items should not be added to the surface of the banner.
5. The SkillsUSA logo must be incorporated in the design. Proper guidelines for the logo can be found on the national website.

6. The words “New York” must be on the banner and clearly visible from 20 feet.
7. Trademark or copyrighted material, photographs, or logos may only be used if written consent is included in the notebook
8. Banners must be constructed by chapter members with guidance from instructors and advisors.
9. This may be a group effort, but only two members of the team will do the presentation part of the contest.
10. Offensive images or text will not be accepted for competition.
11. Graphics and photographs must be clear from ten feet.
12. A maximum of \$200 in bought, donated, or borrowed materials may be spent on the banner.

NOTEBOOK

1. A three-ring binder notebook must be given with the banner.
2. The notebook must not exceed
3. 10 pages (20 faces)
4. The notebook must include the following information and be presented in this
5. order. a. Information about the team that created the banner.
6. How the idea was selected and developed to achieve the final design.
7. Details of construction and printing such as printed by students, taken to a
8. professional printer, done by a graphics company.
9. Equipment and computer programs used to achieve the final product.
10. Cost verification. This must be in the form of a letter from instructor or administrator
11. saying the cost of materials used, donated, or receipts for outside printing.
12. One-page resumes for the two presenters must be included.
