Friendly reminders as you prepare to send your child to camp this summer:

- ☒ **Please send your camper with sunscreen on!** We reapply during the day, but they must come with it already on. We recommend they bring spray sunscreen and a face stick for an easier reapplication process, as we help them reapply. Bug spray can also be packed and applied during the day.
- ☒ **Please send your camper with her bathing suit under her clothes!** It is important your camper comes ready for the day. She can pack an extra bathing suit if she wants to change in between swim times. An extra towel and extra clothes should also be in her bag.
- ☒ **Please send your camper wearing sneakers and bring water shoes in their bag!** If she would like to change into flip flops or water shoes for swim, please pack them in her bag.
- ☒ **Please send your camper with a snack in a separate bag from lunch!** Snacks will not be refrigerated, so make sure it is something that can stay in her backpack. Snacks should be small and easy to eat.
- ☒ **Please send your camper's lunch labeled!** Lunches should be labeled with their name, group, and if there are any nuts/nut free. We recommend putting your camper's lunch in a paper bag so it can be easily disposed of after lunchtime.
- ☒ **Please make sure everything is labeled!** Clothes, towels, goggles, and water bottles can get lost very easily, so make sure anything you are sending is marked with their name!
- ☒ **Pick-ups and early dismissals:** Please send a note with your camper if something different is happening for pickup, or if she is getting picked up early. This can mean she is going home with someone else, or if she is taking the bus when she usually does not. Make sure to let the camp office know something different is happening. If there is no note and no one in the office knows, we will have to follow the regular pickup procedure.
- ☒ **Anything of value:** please make sure all personal belongings stay at home. This includes electronics, fidget toys, jewelry, etc. Things at camp get lost, and we would hate for your campers to lose anything of value.
