Here are a few reminders to help make the most out of each day at this summer!!

- Please have your camper **wear a bathing suit** to camp under their clothes and **bring a second one** in their backpack
- Please pack an extra set of dry “ Just-in-case” clothes in a sealed ziploc bag
- Campers should bring two towels, sunscreen (spray on works best) and a plastic bag for wet bathing suits and towels for the end of the day
- **Sunscreen and bug spray should be applied to your camper prior to coming to camp each morning.** We will reapply sunscreen throughout the day as well. A hat may be helpful in keeping cool from the sun.
- Sneakers should be worn to camp everyday. Watershoes, flipflops, or crocs can be brought for water activities
- **Snacks:** Some Leprechauns may get hungry after swim, so please pack a small snack dry snack **separately from your campers lunch.** Lunches will be stored in the fridge and the snack will be in the campers backpack.
- **Please label your child lunch and snacks with “ Nuts “** if your child lunch contains any nut products as we have some campers who have allergies.
- **Please make sure that everything your child brings to camp is labeled with your child’s name**
- **Hot Lunch:** There is now an option to order lunch online for your camper through **campreminder!** You must order 2 days in advance. We will pick up your campers lunch from the office the day of.
- **Lunch policy:** There is a new camp policy regarding lunches. Unfortunately lunches cannot be placed back in the fridge after lunchtime. If your child doesn’t finish their lunch and it will spoil in their backpack we will ask them to throw away leftovers.
- **Pickups/Early Dismissals/ Transportation changes:** if there is a day that your camper will be picked up early or will be taking a different form of transportation, please submit a note on Campreminder detailing the time and who will be picking up the child. This way, we are able to have your child ready for pick-up at the office. **If there is no note or phone call we must follow the child’s regular departure schedule.**
- **Gadgets or anything of value (jewelry, electronics, fidget toys, etc) should stay at home so nothing gets broken or lost**
- If your child is celebrating a birthday during their time at camp, please let us know so that we can celebrate it ! We do ask that you do not bring in food (cupcakes, cookies, candy, etc) as we cannot distribute it among the group
- Fun theme days (Optional): The Leprachuans will have theme days throughout the summer typically falling on fridays! You will always be informed ahead of time of the groups theme. No need to run to the store for a costume simply be creative with what you already have in your closet :)
- Last, but certainly not least please check your child’s backpack throughout the week as some things may be sent home such as notes and rewards.
