



Welcome to the Munchkins 2026

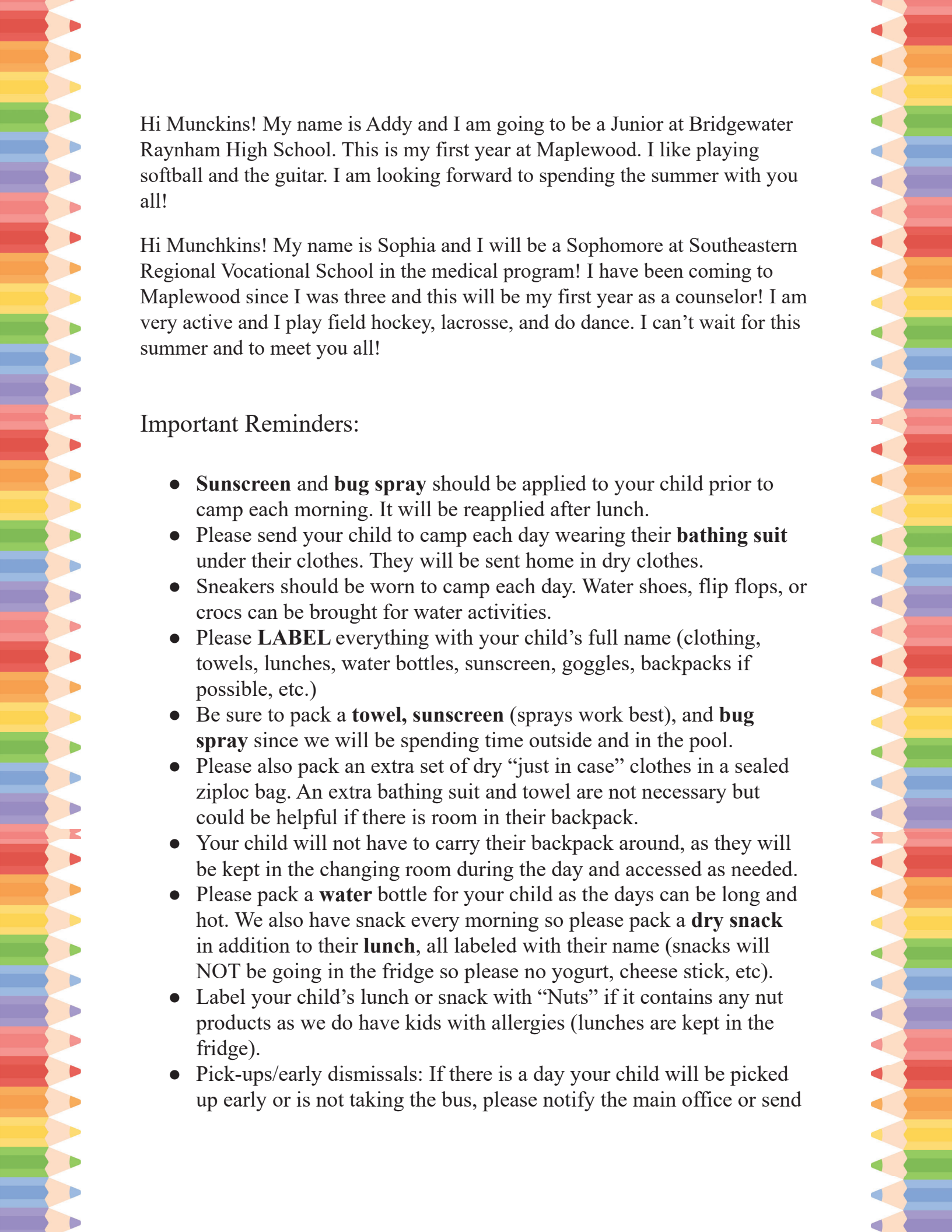
Get to Know the Counselors:

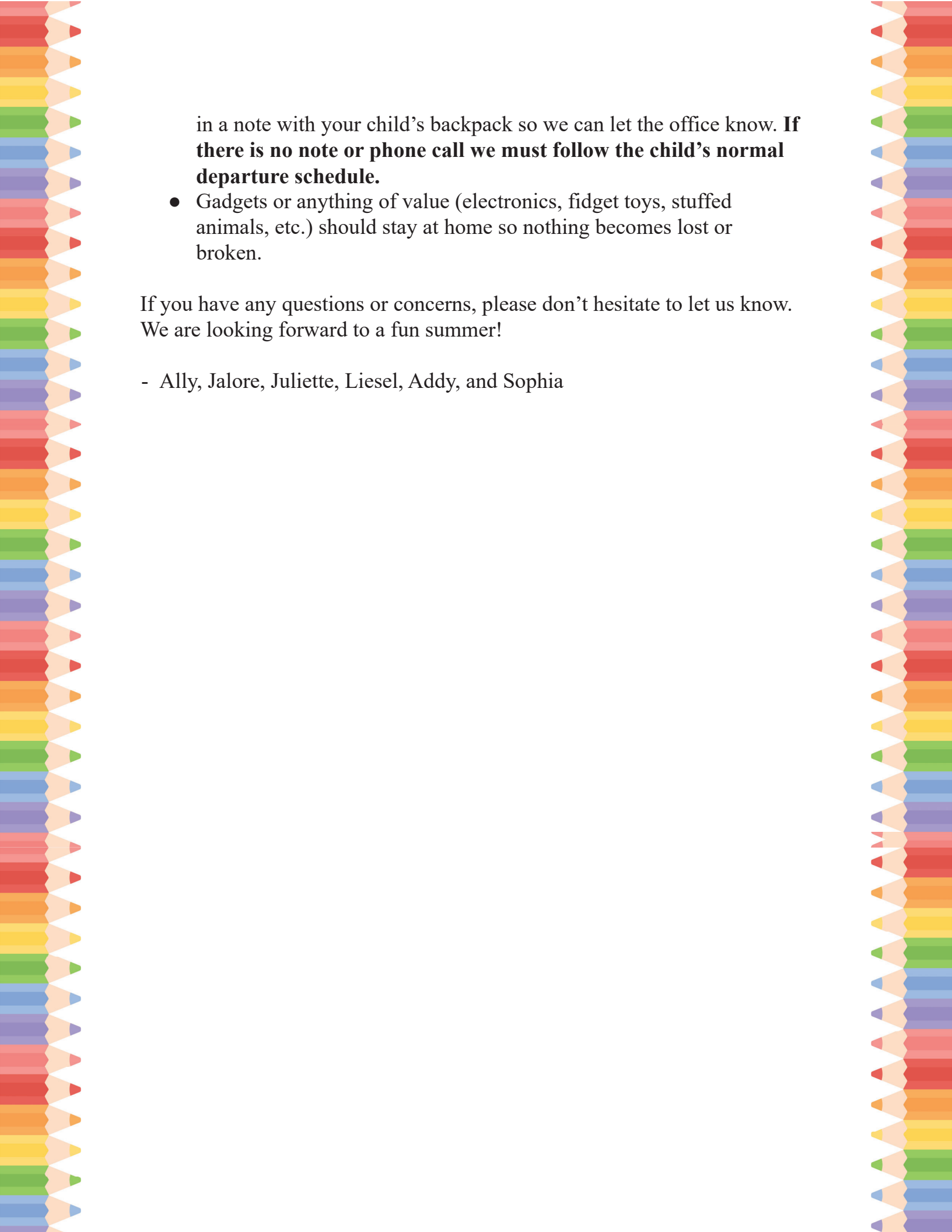

Important Reminders:

- **Sunscreen** and **bug spray** should be applied to your child prior to camp each morning. It will be reapplied after lunch.
- Please send your child to camp each day wearing their **bathing suit** under their clothes. They will be sent home in dry clothes.
- Sneakers should be worn to camp each day. Water shoes, flip flops, or crocs can be brought for water activities.
- Please **LABEL** everything with your child's full name (clothing, towels, lunches, water bottles, sunscreen, goggles, backpacks if possible, etc.)
- Be sure to pack a **towel**, **sunscreen** (sprays work best), and **bug spray** since we will be spending time outside and in the pool.
- Please also pack an extra set of dry "just in case" clothes in a sealed ziploc bag. An extra bathing suit and towel are not necessary but could be helpful if there is room in their backpack.
- Your child will not have to carry their backpack around, as they will be kept in the changing room during the day and accessed as needed.
- Please pack a **water** bottle for your child as the days can be long and hot. We also have snack every morning so please pack a **dry snack** in addition to their **lunch**, all labeled with their name (snacks will NOT be going in the fridge so please no yogurt, cheese stick, etc).
- Label your child's lunch or snack with "Nuts" if it contains any nut products as we do have kids with allergies (lunches are kept in the fridge).
- Pick-ups/early dismissals: If there is a day your child will be picked up early or is not taking the bus, please notify the main office or send



in a note with your child's backpack so we can let the office know. **If there is no note or phone call we must follow the child's normal departure schedule.**

- Gadgets or anything of value (electronics, fidget toys, stuffed animals, etc.) should stay at home so nothing becomes lost or broken.
