REMINDERS/WHAT TO KNOW:

Here are some key reminders as camp season approaches:

- Please send your camper to camp with their bathing suits on/under their clothes and running shoes (sneakers or crocs)!
 - On rainy days, please pack accordingly! Our peanut/rascals love to play in puddles -a pair of rain boots or an extra pair of shoes lets them have even more fun!
- Please send your camper to camp with **sunscreen already applied**, along with sunscreen (labeled with their name) in their backpack; we will reapply throughout the day!
- Things get lost! Please make sure everything your child brings to camp is labeled with their first and last name so we can avoid lost and found.
- Please make sure your camper's lunch and snack are labeled with your child's name and if it contains nuts. Snacks should be separate from lunch and are not refrigerated, so please make sure it can withstand being in the snack bin for a few hours. Lunches will be refrigerated.
- Valuables: Please make sure any personal belongings (ex. toys, electronics, fidgets) stay at home. They can become a distraction or get lost at camp, so we do not want your camper to lose anything of value.
- Pick-ups and early dismissals: Please send a **note** in your campers bag **OR** notify the office if there is going to be a change in pickup time/type (ex. early dismissal or change in transportation). Both the camp office and I should know there has been a change made; if there is no note and the office does not know, we will have to follow the regular pickup procedure.

HERE IS A LIST OF WHAT SHOULD BE IN YOUR CAMPER'S BAG:

1. Nonperishable Snack - labeled with name and if containing nuts
2. Lunch - again, labeled with name and if containing nuts
3. **ONE** towel, no need for two! Backpacks are small and peanut/rascals towels get hung up to dry :)
4. Swim supplies (goggles, water shoes/flip flops) *Swim diapers are **not** allowed at camp
5. Water bottle
6. Ziploc bag with sunscreen and bug spray - labeled with name
7. Ziploc bag with a change of clothes for after swim
8. Ziploc bag with a spare swimsuit & clothes labeled "SPARE"
9. Anything else your camper may require
