Here are a few reminders as you prepare to send your child to camp this summer:

- If you take a peek at our group schedule attached below, you will see that we have swim first, so if your child could come to camp in a bathing suit that would ensure they are ready when they get to Maplewood!
- Please apply sunscreen and bug spray before your child comes to camp, and your child can always reapply throughout the day.
- It is extremely important that your child comes to camp with a water bottle and a snack. We have the 12:30 lunch slot during the day so it is important that your child has the option to eat snack in the morning. We also encourage campers to stay hydrated and refill their water bottles throughout the day. And please keep in mind that snacks and water bottles should come **separate** from your campers lunch.
- Please make sure everything your camper brings is **labeled!!!** Goggles, towels, clothes, water bottles, and everything else can get lost very quickly, but if your camper's name is on the item it can be returned easily!
- If there is anything you want the staff or the front office to know, such as early pickups or change in dismissal, please send in a note with your camper and remind them to give the note to a counselor. But you can always call the office!
- Please have your camper bring shoes everyday to camp, crocs or other water shoes are fine for before or after swimming.
- If there happens to be a rainy day please send your child with proper attire, such as rain coat, rain boots, and a change of clothes.
