Booking & Payment

Bookings can be made by submitting a booking request on the website, by email, telephone or WhatsApp. Once reviewed and instructor availability confirmed, you will receive a booking reservation email with an invoice and payment instructions.

You can pay with a secure online payment link (we use SumUp) or by simple bank transfer.

Full payment is required at the time of booking (unless agreed otherwise in writing). Full payment confirms the booking and creates a contract between you, Pulse Snowsports, and your instructor.

Once full payment is received you will receive a Booking Confirmation email with all the details.

Cancellation Policy

Our cancellation policy is different for Switzerland, France & UK. Please refer to our full cancellation policy on the website.

Insurance

Insurance is not included in the price of Pulse Snowsports lessons. It is the client's responsibility to have appropriate coverage, including:

- Third-party liability insurance
- Health insurance
- Accident and rescue insurance (mandatory for off-piste skiing)

Liability

Pulse Snowsports cannot accept liability for accidents that occur during ski or snowboard lessons. Clients are strongly advised to have their own personal accident insurance.

For those in Verbier, you can also take out accident insurance at the Televerbier ticket office when purchasing your lift pass. The insurance costs 5 CHF per day and covers:

- Refund of lift passes
- Ski lesson costs
- Equipment rental in case of illness, accident, or lift closure

Off-Piste Lessons

Clients are responsible for ensuring they have the appropriate equipment for off-piste skiing. At a minimum, this includes a transceiver, shovel, and avalanche probe. Avalanche safety equipment can be arranged for hire before the lesson. Clients without the required safety equipment will not be permitted to ski off-piste. Please also ensure that your insurance covers off-piste skiing.

Video & Photo Consent

During lessons, activities, or events, our team may occasionally take photos or videos for promotional and marketing purposes. These images may be used on Pulse Snowsports' official channels, including our website, social media platforms, and other marketing materials.

By participating in our sessions, you give your consent for Pulse Snowsports to capture and use such content, unless you have specifically requested otherwise.

If you do not wish to appear in any photos or videos, please let your instructor or a member of the Pulse Snowsports team know before your session begins, or email us in advance at general@pulsesnowsports.com
