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Grading Policy

At PS 152, we are committed to ensuring that grades are fair, consistent, and focused on student learning.

Our grading policy is designed so that a student's grade reflects what they know and can do, regardless of which classroom they are in. By using common expectations across schools, families can feel confident that grades are based on academic standards and evidence of learning.

What Do Grades Tell Me?

Grades communicate your child's progress toward grade-level learning standards in:

- Reading
- Writing
- Mathematics

Grades are intended to provide meaningful information about your child's strengths and areas for growth.

Grades Reflect Learning. Behavior and work habits are reported separately on report cards.

Academic grades are based on:

- ✓ **Demonstration of skills and understanding**
- ✓ **Classwork, assessments, and performance tasks**
- ✓ **Progress toward grade-level standards**

Academic grades are not based on:

- ✗ **Effort alone**
- ✗ **Participation alone**
- ✗ **Behavior**

Understanding the 1-4 Grading Scale

PS 152 uses the NYC Public Schools standards-based grading scale.

<u>Level</u>	<u>Meaning</u>	<u>Description</u>
4	Exceeds Standards	Student consistently demonstrates grade-level skills and often goes beyond expectations.
3	Meets Standards	The student consistently demonstrates grade-level expectations.
2	Approaching Standards	The student is developing grade-level skills but still needs support in some areas.
1	Well Below Standards	Student requires significant support to meet grade-level expectations.



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What Is My Child Being Graded On?

Reading

- Reads with sufficient accuracy and fluency to support comprehension
- Reads and comprehends grade-level texts independently across genres
- Demonstrates comprehension by referring to text details
- Grades 1–2 only: Uses letter-sound relationships to figure out new words

Writing

- Writes independently for different tasks/purposes/audiences (opinion, informative, narrative)
- Uses details and facts from the text in writing
- Revises writing to clarify and add details

Mathematics

- Demonstrates understanding of mathematical concepts
- Solves problems with precision and accuracy
- Solves problems in multiple ways and explains solutions

Science

- **Demonstrates an understanding of science content and concepts**
- **Uses reading, writing, and mathematics to gather, interpret, and use evidence in science content and concepts.**
- **Makes and tests predictions, seeks answers, and develops solutions.**

Social Studies

- **Demonstrates an understanding of social studies content and concepts**
- **Uses reading and writing to gather, interpret, and use evidence in social studies content and concepts**
- **Applies critical thinking to extend understanding of content and concepts**

Gym

- **Participates in physical activity and demonstrates ability in age-appropriate movement, control, and fitness skills**
- **Demonstrates an understanding of the basic parts of health-related fitness and the connection between physical activity and wellness**



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How Are Grades Determined?

Teachers use multiple sources of evidence throughout each marking period. Using multiple measures ensures that grades reflect ongoing learning rather than a single test score.

Reading and Writing Evidence

- Reading responses
- Writing assignments
- Module assessments
- Performance tasks
- Foundations assessments (Grades K-2)

Mathematics Evidence

- Unit assessments
- Daily checkpoints (Grades 3-5)
- "Show What You Know" tasks (Grades K-2)
- Classroom problem-solving activities

- Marking Period 1: September 10 - October 30, 2026
- Marking Period 2: November 2 - December 23, 2026
- Marking Period 3: January 4 - February 26, 2027
- Marking Period 4: March 1 - May 28, 2027

Support for All Learners

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Frequently Asked Questions

Why did PS 152 adopt this grading approach?

The goal is to ensure that grading is consistent across classrooms so families receive clear, accurate information about student learning.

Can a student improve their grade during the marking period?

Yes. Teachers use multiple pieces of evidence collected throughout the marking period to determine report card grades.

Are homework and behavior included in academic grades?

No. Academic grades reflect mastery of learning standards. Behavior and work habits are reported separately.

What should I do if I have questions about my child's grades?

Families are encouraged to contact their child's teacher to discuss:

- Academic progress
- Areas of strength
- Areas for growth
- Available supports and next steps
