

Yukon Provincial Health Insurance Plan: Fact Sheet

Services Provided by Yukon Health Care Plan, Pharmacare, and Extended Health Benefits (EHB):

Prescription Drugs	 Seniors (65+): 100% coverage for all drugs on the Yukon formulary (lowest-cost generic). Children's Drug & Optical Program (CDOP): Assists low-income families after a deductible (\$250/child, \$500/family). Chronic Disease Program: For residents with specified chronic illnesses; deductible applies (\$250 individual, \$500 family).
Ambulance	 Emergency medevac (air ambulance) within Yukon is covered. No coverage for ambulance or medevac services outside Yukon.
Dental Benefits	 No coverage for routine dental care. Yukon Dental Program provides up to \$1,300/year for low-income residents without private coverage, plus a \$600 top-up for seniors. Children's dental care covered under public school-based programs. The Canadian Dental Care Plan (CDCP) is covered by the federal government.
Eye Care Services	 Seniors (65+ or 60+ with a spouse 65+): one exam, new lenses, and up to \$100 for frames every 2 years. Low-income children (0-18) receive coverage under CDOP. Intraocular lenses covered once per eye for cataract surgery.
Hospitals	Coverage for standard ward rooms only.
Hearing Aids	 Children (0-15) without private coverage: full coverage for hearing aids. Seniors (65+ or 60+ with spouse 65+): one hearing aid per ear every 4 years through EHB.

No coverage for other adults.



Services Provided by Yukon Health Care Plan, Pharmacare, and Extended Health Benefits (EHB):

Medical Pharmacare/EHB covers approved medical supplies and equipment (wheelchairs, prostheses, respiratory aids) for Supplies seniors and eligible residents. **Nursing and** Home Care Program provides nursing, personal care, therapy, respite, and equipment based on assessed **Home Care** need. **Benefits Paramedical** In-hospital physiotherapy and occupational therapy covered. No coverage for chiropractic, massage therapy, naturopathy, or other paramedical services. Coverage across Canada at Yukon rates (Quebec bills Out of Country Outside Canada, reimbursed at Yukon rates only; residents responsible for excess costs. No coverage for ambulance or medevac outside Yukon.
