

## Cookie Policy for ILICDEV Portfolio

### 1. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer or mobile device when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently and provide information to the owners of the site.

Cookies set by the website owner (in this case, ILICDEV Portfolio) are called "first-party cookies." Cookies set by parties other than the website owner are called "third-party cookies." Third-party cookies enable third-party features or functionality to be provided on or through the website (e.g., advertising, interactive content, and analytics).

### 2. Why We Use Cookies

We use cookies for several reasons. Some cookies are required for technical reasons for our website to operate. Other cookies enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance their experience on our website.

### 3. Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for you to browse the website and use its features. They enable basic functions like page navigation, access to secure areas of the website, and remember information you enter into forms. Without these cookies, services you have asked for cannot be provided.

Examples of Strictly Necessary Cookies:

Session cookies that keep you logged in

Security cookies for authentication

Load balancing cookies for distributing web traffic

Can be disabled: No - These cookies cannot be disabled as they are essential for the website to function.

### 4. Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect information about how visitors use our website, such as which pages are visited most often, how users navigate through the site, and if they receive error messages from web pages. These cookies don't collect information that identifies individual visitors. All information collected is aggregated and anonymous.

Examples of Analytics Cookies:

Google Analytics (\_ga, \_gid, \_gat)

Page view tracking cookies

Visitor behavior analysis cookies

Purpose: We use this information to improve how our website works and understand user behavior.

Can be disabled: Yes - You can opt out of these cookies without affecting website functionality.

## 5. Performance Cookies

These cookies allow us to count visits and traffic sources so we can measure and improve the performance of our website. They help us understand which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous.

Purpose: If you do not allow these cookies, we will not know when you have visited our site and will not be able to monitor its performance.

Can be disabled: Yes - Website functionality will not be affected.

## 6. Functionality Cookies

These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalization. They may be set by us or by third-party providers whose services we have added to our pages. These cookies allow the website to remember choices you make (such as your username, language, or region) and provide enhanced, more personal features.

Examples:

Language preference cookies

Theme/appearance preference cookies

User interface customization cookies

Remember login details

Can be disabled: Yes - However, disabling these cookies may affect website features and services available to you.

## 7. How to Control Cookies

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject cookies. You can exercise your cookie preferences by adjusting the settings in your web browser.

### Browser Controls

Most web browsers allow you to control cookies through their settings preferences. However, if you limit the ability of websites to set cookies, you may impact your overall user experience, as some features may no longer function properly.

Google Chrome: Settings > Privacy and security > Cookies and other site data

Mozilla Firefox: Options > Privacy & Security > Cookies and Site Data

Safari: Preferences > Privacy > Cookies and website data

Microsoft Edge: Settings > Privacy, search, and services > Cookies and site permissions
