PRELIMINARY NOTICE TO THE ATHLETE SELECTION PROCEDURES
2027 Pan American Games
Men’s and Women’s SUP SURF & SUP TECHNICAL RACE
April 22, 2026

To provide qualification pathway information in a timely manner, USOPC IMS – Surfing in collaboration with USA Surfing is releasing this Preliminary Notice to the Athlete Selection Procedures for the 2027 Pan American Games (“PAG”). This document is being written as a complement, and not a substitute to the 2027 Pan American Games Athlete Selection Procedures. Additional communication will be released once the Athlete Selection Procedures have been completed.

A. Anticipated Athlete Eligibility Criteria:

- Athletes must comply with all International Surfing Association (ISA) eligibility requirements posted at <https://isasurf.org/about-isa/isa-rulebook/>
- Athletes must be a national of the United States and hold a valid U.S. passport that will not expire for six months after the conclusion of the PAG.
- Athletes must have an active USA Surfing Membership
- Athletes must adhere to all USOPC, USADA, WADA, and ISA anti-doping protocols, policies, and procedures including participation in Out-of-Competition Testing, if applicable.
- Athletes must comply with the applicable Background Check Policy and Athlete Safety Policy.

B. Pan American Games Qualification System Overview:

- The maximum quota allocated is one (1) surfer per gender. Quota is awarded by name at the following events in the presumed hierarchical order.

SUP SURF (9 Surfers per gender – Max 1 per country)

- I. **3** – ISA World SUP & Paddleboard Championship 2027 (if this competition is not held before Lima 2027, the results of the 2026 ISA World SUP & Paddleboard Championship will be considered)
- II. **4** – PASA Pan American Surfing Games 2027
- III. **1** – PASA Pan American Surfing Games 2026
- IV. **1** – Host Country (Peru)

SUP TECHNICAL RACE (10 Racers per gender – Max 1 per country)

- I. **3** – ISA World SUP & Paddleboard Championship 2027 (if this competition is not held before Lima 2027, the results of the 2026 ISA World SUP & Paddleboard Championship will be considered)
- II. **4** – PASA Pan American Surfing Games 2027
- III. **1** – PASA Pan American Surfing Games 2026
- IV. **1**– Athlete from the 2026 South American Games Santa Fe
- V. **1** – Host Country (Peru)

C. Anticipated Evaluation Events to Qualify for the 2027 PAG Team:

It is intended that athletes being considered for nomination to the 2027 PAG Team may be evaluated on their performance at any of the below listed events.



