TUTORING

StudyTime offers weekly tutoring to students in grades K-8 at three different sites in Dallas. During our sessions, students receive homework help, activities to expand math and reading skills, and opportunities for social-emotional learning, all to prepare them for the next grade level.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Once students reach 8th grade, they have the opportunity to apply for scholarships to local private high schools. While most students attend Catholic schools, they can apply to any private school of their choice. These scholarships make it possible for students to attend high-quality schools that set them up for college and career success.

PARENT SUPPORT

StudyTime also provides support for parents and caregivers. Many are unfamiliar with the American school system, and language barriers often present additional challenges. Bilingual, certified facilitators help them to navigate the school system, advocate for their children, and support their academic success.



After graduating from high school, StudyTime Alumni have the opportunity to apply for college scholarships as well.
