In January 1956 the first conference of The Society of St. Vincent de Paul in the Diocese of Dallas began meeting at Holy Trinity Parish. Those trailblazers set the path for the Society to grow.

In the Diocese of Dallas there are now 40 parishes with active conferences and more than 800 volunteer members, and we continue to recruit new members in some of the other 34 parishes in the Diocese.

On January 31 we will begin to celebrate this 70th anniversary by gathering at The National Cathedral Shrine of Our Lady of Guadalupe for a special Recommitment Mass with Archbishop Andrew Bellisario, C.M., Archbishop of Anchorage–Juneau and the National Episcopal Advisor to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul.
