Spond

We use the app *Spond* as the choir's communication channel. Here you will receive information about rehearsals and concerts, and it is where you report absences. To register in AKF's Spond group, you need to fill out this form:

What is Expected of You

- You must attend rehearsals.
- If you are sick or have other necessary absences, you must report this in Spond.
- You are expected to practice on your own between rehearsals.
- You must participate in mandatory choir assignments.

Membership Fee

The membership fee per semester is NOK 700 for full-time students and NOK 1500 for other members. In addition, the female singers must pay NOK 500 as a deposit for a choir robe. You will get this money back when you finish your period with AKF.

Sheet Music and Practice Tips

Sheet music is distributed at rehearsals, and the cost is covered by the membership fee. You must always bring your sheet music to rehearsals.

"Lefsa" is a bound booklet of music that each member receives when they join the choir. It contains various songs that make up the choir's standard repertoire. This booklet is mostly used for group singing at celebrations.

To practice the pieces we sing, we recommend using Cyberbass.org. Here you can listen to a selection of pieces in all voices and at different speeds. It can also be useful to use YouTube or ask experienced members who may have sung the piece before.

Concert Attire

The choir's official concert attire is formal black clothing with black shoes and black socks or tights. Traditionally, female members wear black dresses (knee-length with covered shoulders). For university events, female members wear the choir's black robes, which are rented from the choir and returned at the end of membership. Male members are expected to wear a black suit with a white shirt, black bow tie, and black shoes. Sheet music must always be in a black folder.

What matters most is that the overall look is cohesive and formal, small deviations from tradition are perfectly fine as long as the general impression is maintained.

Positions and Committees

The choir has various committees responsible for social events, communications, and concerts. Members are elected at the annual meeting, but there is always room for contributions! Active committees today include:

- PR Committee (3 members)
- Individuals as "Sheet music manager", "Auditor" and "Election Manager"
