## What We Are Learning

### Phonics

Students will dive deeper into learning about vowels. They will explore both short and long vowel sounds and practice reading words such as car and cage. In addition, students will continue to build their skills by reading CVC words.

### Reading:

Students will learn a new reading comprehension strategy focused on identifying character traits and character feelings. They will also continue to build their understanding of problem and solution, as well as theme.

### Writing

Students will continue developing their creative writing pieces as they work through each step of the writing process, expanding on their creativity and ideas.

### Math

Students will be learning how to identify 2-D and 3-D shapes in order to solve problems in real-world mathematical situations.

### Social Studies

Students will learn about the five boroughs and different landmarks in NYC, such as the Brooklyn Bridge and the Empire State Building.

### Science

Students will learn how to make objects such as a ball and a toy car move faster or slower by using ramps.
