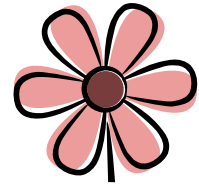




# Kindergarten Newsletter

## What we are learning

**Phonics:** Students will continue learning how to tap and blend sounds to read words with digraphs like thin, chip, shun, duck, and whip. They will also practice new trick (sight) words.

**Reading:** Students will continue practicing different reading comprehension strategies such as, topic and theme, story elements, making predictions, and making inferences.

**Writing:** Students will be working on a book making project full of their contributions to a class book!

**Math:** Students will learn subtraction, identifying when to add and subtract, and practicing multiple solving strategies.

**Social Studies:** Students will continue learning how to use maps and globes to locate places in their neighborhood and exploring maps of New York City's neighborhoods and boroughs.

**Science:** Students will continue learning about sunlight, temperature, and different types of weather.
