**School Leadership Team Meeting**

**The meeting was called to order. The minutes from the previous meeting were read and approved by Ms.Petite and Ms.Howell.**

Ms. Campbell chaired the meeting and facilitated the review of the Comprehensive Educational Plan (CEP), with the team focusing on Priority 1. The team examined school data trends, identified root causes, and discussed the priority needs that will guide the development of the school's goals.

Ms. Polight reviewed the proposed Priority 1 goals and emphasized that each goal must be directly aligned with the school's data and identified areas of need. She asked the team to determine the measures that will be used to monitor progress toward each goal and recommended using the January practice assessments as a mid-year benchmark to evaluate student growth and inform instructional adjustments.

The team reviewed the proposed English Language Arts (ELA) goals and made revisions to ensure they reflected the school's current data and priorities. Following discussion, the team approved the updated ELA goals.

The team also discussed the school's Attendance goal, emphasizing the importance of increasing student attendance to ensure all students have access to high-quality instruction and learning experiences throughout the school year.

The team reviewed the proposed mathematics goals and the assessment tools that will be used to monitor student progress throughout the school year.

The following assessment measures will be used:

- Edmentum
- i-Ready
- Acadience (Grades K–2)
- MAP Growth (Grades 3–5)

The team agreed that baseline assessment data will be collected in September and used to measure student growth throughout the school year. A target of a 10% increase in student achievement from the beginning to the end of the school year was established. The team discussed the importance of using multiple data sources throughout the year to monitor progress and make instructional decisions that support student achievement.

The meeting was adjourned. The motion to adjourn was seconded by Ms. Campbell.
