




Ria Bailey finds herself in quite a fix, and it's all because of a strange treasure that turns up in the mail one fateful day.

A devastatingly gifted mage with clandestine romantic connections to a Royal Guard joins the court social season in an attempt to undo past wrongs, only to fall under suspicion when a creature with powers shockingly like her own begins slaughtering her fellow debutantes.

Pandora Small has two ruling objectives: first, to keep the prodigious extent of her power secret, in a world where mages are feared and governed by suffocating laws. Second, to find her wealthy and noble-born patron, a shadowy figure bound to Pandora by magic, who stole her childhood and grew her power until she became a weapon rather than a girl. To that end, she's posing as an Ingenue, a privileged and petted young woman of strictly limited abilities, who is allowed access to the royal court's

social season in order to find a husband and patron to control her magic.

But on Pandora's arrival at court, Kit Beacon, one of the most promising members of the Royal Guard, inadvertently learns the true scope of her power. Privately sympathetic towards mages and the difficulties they face, Beacon decides to keep Pandora's secret. But when someone or something with powers terribly like Pandora's own begins slaughtering her fellow Ingenues, Beacon's resolve to keep what he knows about her private is put to the test.

Tasked with protecting all the girls in the palace, not just one, Beacon will have to decide whether Pandora is a suspect or an ally, while to win his trust, Pandora will have to let him know more of her still—the worst of who she is and what she's done. Because only unity between them during the social whirlwind to come will enable Pan to find her patron and Beacon the killer, and ensure they both see justice meted out.

Pia and her brother, Max, live on an isolated farm in rural Maine, and it's the only life they remember. Their father says the only way for them to stay protected is to stay on the farm. Pia doesn't question it. Pia's entire world turns upside down when her father breaks

his leg, and she must be the one to venture into town to make farm deliveries.

Edith has always been a good girl—she has to be, or her foster family might think she's like her violent father. No matter how much anger simmers inside her, she keeps it buried, hidden...

Until the day she's pushed a step too far, and that anger comes bursting out in the form of literal claws.

It's then that Edith learns she's a berserkr, a descendant of ancient Norse warriors with the ability to turn into animals. To avoid jail for attacking a student, Edith is shipped off to the mysterious Skallagrim Academy. The ancient school is supposedly a haven for people like her, a place where she can learn to control her powers and then push them down so deep that they'll never come out again.

But someone—or something—is stalking the dark halls of Skallagrim.



As a priestess paid to guide the deceased home, Kang Siying has never feared death. But when her beloved father collapses, Siying realizes that even she is not free from the cruel grasp of mortality. Desperate to provide her father with the medical aid he needs, Siying accepts a dangerous job that promises a generous commission, and travels to a hostile state to retrieve the corpse of a missing prince.

But the moment Siying places her reanimation talisman on the dead prince's head, rather than make the corpse obedient to Siying's commands, the talisman brings the prince back to life. something greater, and each day has her chafing more at the boundaries of her society.



A contemporary reimagining of the story of Sita from *The Ramayana*, SUCH GREAT HEIGHTS deals with family secrets and courtroom drama, and asks the question: does the truth matter if no one believes it?

Because a betrayal sent her older sister into a deep depression, Siya values the truth above all else. Someday, she wants to become a truth-exposing lawyer, like her mother who died several years earlier.

For now, she's working hard to earn a spot as an attorney on her high school's mock trial team, even though the details of this year's case are eerily similar to the car accident that killed her mother. When Siya makes the team and Raj Raghavan, Senator's son


and star of the mock trial team and the soccer field, asks her out, everything seems perfect, even if Siya struggles with adjusting to life in the spotlight with Raj. And the more she digs into who wrote the mock trial case, the more questions she has about her mother and the darker aspects of her personality that no one ever talks about.

During a "team-building" game of Assassin, Siya ends up trapped for a night in a locked storage room with school bad boy Raven, and the school buzzes with gossip.
