PREAMBLE

The Wallet Payment, also referred to as prepaid credit inside the IZIX Solution, is an option made available to certain Customer(s) and to certain Users by IZIX SRL. Under this invoicing and payment process, the Customer directly invoices its services to the User, and the Customer delegates to IZIX SRL the establishment of the invoice to the User. The User authorizes IZIX SRL to make the payment for the Customer’s invoice, and IZIX SRL will ensure payment of the Customer’s invoice using the User’s available credits. This appendix specifically applies to the use of the Wallet Payment by the User.

The Parties hereby agree as follows:

1. SCOPE

- 1.1 This Appendix 5 describes the specific terms and conditions applicable to the use of the Wallet Payment.
- 1.2 The prices and invoices for the use of the Customer’s services by the User are directly established between the Customer and the User. Consequently, the Customer sends its invoice to the User and the User pays the Customer’s invoices. IZIX agrees to facilitate the invoicing and payment process as established in this Appendix 5 with Wallet Payment.
- 1.3 The User agrees to pay a provision into IZIX’s Stripe account. In return, IZIX will grant the User a number of credits on the User’s wallet corresponding to the amount of the provision paid by the User. With these credits, the User will have access to the Customer’s services and the User’s credits will be automatically withdrawn from the User wallet upon the use of the Customer’s services. The User authorizes IZIX to pay any amount due to the Customer on behalf of the User by deducting the amounts made available by the User on IZIX’s Stripe account. The User is responsible for the recharge of its wallet with new credits from time to time to continue its use of the services. The User may reclaim any sums deposited into IZIX’s Stripe account that have not been used at any moment.
- 1.4 The Wallet Payment is solely applicable to the use of the IZIX Services by the Users who have been authorized to use the Wallet Payment by IZIX.
- 1.5 This Appendix 5 sets forth the specific terms and conditions for the use of the Wallet Payment in the framework of the Agreement.

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 Capitalized words not defined in this article shall have the meaning set forth in Data Protection Legislation where relevant, or in the Agreement.
- 2.2 Capitalized words used in the Agreement shall exclusively have the following meaning:
 - 2.2.1 **“Wallet Payment”** means the invoicing and payment method for the User’s utilization of the Customer’s services, wherein the Customer delegates the generation of the invoices for the use of its service to IZIX, the invoices are issued for the User, and IZIX is authorized by the User to pay the Customer’s invoice. The User’s payment is executed through a credit wallet funded by the User through a Third Party.

3. INVOICE DELEGATION

- 3.1 The Customer hereby delegates to IZIX the responsibility for the establishment and issuance of invoices to the Users, in relation to the use of the Customer’s services. IZIX accepts this delegation and agrees to fulfil all duties associated with the invoicing process, including but

- 3.2 When this information is not included in the IZIX Solution or otherwise already available for IZIX or upon specific request from IZIX, the Customer shall provide IZIX, at least each month, with all necessary information and documentation required for the accurate and timely issuance of invoices, including details of goods and services provided, quantities, prices, and any applicable taxes, including Value Added Tax (VAT).
- 3.3 IZIX agrees to ensure that all invoices issued on behalf of the Customer comply with all legal requirements, including those related to VAT.
- 3.4 The Customer shall be responsible for collecting and remitting any VAT applicable to the invoices issued on behalf of the Customer in accordance with the relevant tax laws and regulations.
- 3.5 IZIX will generate invoices for the Customer based on the information provided by the Customer. The Customer guarantees that the information provided to IZIX is accurate. IZIX is not liable for any errors in the invoices resulting from a lack of information provided to it or errors in the information communicated to it. The prices of the Customer’s services are determined by the Customer in the agreement concluded between the Customer and the User, as well as the payment deadlines and applicable penalties in case of late payment or non-payment of invoices. IZIX is in no way responsible for non-payment of the invoice by the User, nor for any delay in payment, and IZIX is not responsible for the implementation of any penalties that may be applicable in case of non-payment or late payment of the invoice by the User.
- 3.6 The Customer acknowledges that it remains ultimately responsible for the accuracy and legality of the invoices issued on its behalf by IZIX and shall indemnify and hold harmless IZIX from any claims, losses, or liabilities arising from any inaccuracies, errors, or omissions in the invoicing process.
- 3.7 This delegation of invoicing responsibilities shall remain in effect until terminated by mutual agreement of both Parties or as otherwise specified in a separate written agreement between the Parties or pursuant to the provisions of the General Terms and Conditions-License.

4. SERVICE FEES

- 4.1 In order to facilitate this service, cover collection and management fees of the Wallet, IZIX will perceive a 5% commission on the amount due to the client, function of users’ credits’ usage.

5. LOCATION OF CUSTOMER’S SERVICES PROVISION

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed between the Parties that the provision of services by the Customer, including the services of providing parking spaces for vehicles, is located at the premises of the building in which the Customer’s Parking Lot used by the User is located.
