La Croix was planted 37 years ago in Cape Girardeau, Missouri. Planted with a focus on reaching those outside the church and leading them to follow Jesus, we have grown in the last ten years to have an increasingly healthy culture of intentional discipleship to help create maturing disciples of Jesus. La Croix has over 2,400 that attend weekly worship services. We are a non-denominational church, connected to a growing network of churches across the country, and we draw from the theological streams of Arminian, Wesleyan, Evangelical, and Charismatic traditions. La Croix is a church that does ministry in teams, believing that this healthier and reflects the community that Jesus has called the church to. We have several communities that are a part of the La Croix family outside of the Cape Campus such as our Campus Ministry at the near-by state university, a multi-cultural congregation, a Campus in Benton, MO, and a Gathering in Sikeston, MO.
