VICTORIAN CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (VCE)

- Studies in Year 11 and Year 12 prepare students for tertiary courses at higher education institutions, including Holmes Institute, anywhere in Australia.
- At the successful completion of Year 12, students are awarded the Victorian Certificate of Education (VCE). Students will not receive an ATAR score.
- VCE Intakes: Year 11 February/April/July; Year 12 January

VICTORIAN CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (VOCATIONAL MAJOR)

- Studies in Year 11 VCE and Year 12 VCE Vocational Major in preparing students for vocational pathways for both TAFE and Vocational course providers.

AIRPORT RECEPTION

Holmes can arrange for students to be met at the airport and transferred to their chosen accommodation.



ACCOMMODATION

Students wishing to participate in the Homestay program are placed with carefully selected and monitored host families. Homestay families are chosen for their ability to help students with their English language and to provide welfare support for students. In addition, for students over 18 years of age, apartments and hostels are available in close proximity to the city location of Holmes Grammar School. Holmes can provide a placement in such accommodation if requested.



STUDENT CARE – 24 HOUR CONTACT

Holmes offers an around-the-clock, seven days a week care program including a 24- hour security contact and emergency telephone service. Individual counselling is available to students in need of specialised attention and guidance in personal and health matters. Assistance with medical and banking requirements is also provided.



CARE PROVIDERS

Holmes ensures that students under 18 years of age have an experienced Care Provider who looks after the student's welfare, behaviour, and health, assisting them to understand the school's requirements.



FURTHER STUDY & CAREER GUIDANCE

Holmes offers guidance to students concerning their further study options and career possibilities. This guidance is structured and on-going to take account of changing circumstances.



STUDY SUPPORT

In addition to detailed study guides for all units of study, each student has access to a staff member who monitors progress and provides mentoring advice.
