DEARLY DEPARTED

It was with great sadness that the village learned of Dave Smith's sudden and untimely death. Dave made a valuable contribution to village life in many ways, in his characteristic self effacing style. In 2001 he became the founding member of Eggleston Carnival Committee along with his wife Sandra. It was Dave who wrote to every member of the village community asking if they were in favour of putting Christmas lights on the trees on the village green, and following an overwhelming response, funds poured in to support the project. It was Dave who instigated putting the electricity boxes on the village green so that, over the years, more Christmas lights could be added to brighten the dark days of December.

In 2004 Dave Smith joined the Eggleston Village Hall Committee, where he held positions of Treasurer and Chairman. In these roles Dave was instrumental in establishing Hallmark Status for the hall, which is a nationally recognised quality assurance scheme for village halls and community spaces. Dave worked tirelessly, alongside members of the committee, to ensure the hall was kept in good condition and functioned as a valuable village asset.

Following the death of his wife, Sandra, in 2023, Dave continued to serve the village hall, and did so until his sudden death on 26th September 2024. Dave Smith was a valuable member of the Eggleston Village community who, in addition to the above more public roles, was also a formidable dominoes player, captain of Three Tuns Inn pool team, and often seen walking his beloved dogs. His presence will be sorely missed. Our thoughts and prayers are with his family and friends.
