Exhibition 2026 at Eggleston Village Hall

Exploring the industrial heritage of Eggleston.

For my next exhibition I will be exploring the history of the London Lead Company and their impact upon shaping our village. Much of our housing and even our village hall can trace their roots from the emergence of industrial scale lead mining in the local area. We'll look at the foundation of mining resulting from the discovery of Galena ore on Eggleston Moor, and follow the rise and fall of the company that played an enormous part in shaping much of our local surroundings and facilities. We will be able to learn about the smelting processes used at Blackton Mill as well as view many underground photographs showing the conditions that our mining ancestors had to endure. On display will be many genuine mining artefacts to view as we follow the advancement in lighting, ranging from candle cradles through to the use of a variety lamps.
