- Students who arrive at school after 7:45am must be walked into the school office by a guardian who will sign the student in. The student will be given a tardy slip to admit to class.
- Students who check out of school due to illness cannot return to school until they have been fever-free without medication for 24 hours. Children with a fever at school must be picked up immediately.
- Early check-out procedures are similar. Parent/guardian must report to the school office who will sign the student out. The latest time to check out a student is 2:15pm.

Happy Summer!

I usually attend Saturday afternoon Mass, but this past weekend I wanted to participate in the Feast of Corpus Christi Mass and Eucharistic Procession at Most Blessed Sacrament. When I woke up Sunday morning, I found myself saying, “I have to go to Mass this morning.” After saying it a third time, I stopped and corrected myself: “Cheri, you don’t have to go to Mass this morning—you get to go to Mass this morning.”

In that moment, my attitude completely changed. What had felt like another item on my to-do list suddenly became an opportunity filled with anticipation and joy. Instead of simply getting ready for church, I found myself excited about attending Mass and receiving Jesus in the Eucharist.

One of the greatest blessings of adulthood is recognizing the many ways God speaks to us through the Mass, and this past Sunday was no exception. Father Todd began his homily with the story of a man who had been found guilty of treason, imprisoned, and sentenced to death. On the day of his execution, he requested the Most Blessed Sacrament as his final meal.

Father Todd went on to explain that if we are to become children of God and receive eternal life, it is Jesus Himself who must nourish us. The Eucharist is the most important reality in the universe and the most precious gift God has given us. It is Christ truly present among us, and it should be the center of our lives, taking priority over everything else.

As I reflected on Father Todd’s words, I was especially grateful that my Sunday morning mindset had shifted from obligation to joyful anticipation. On the Feast of Corpus Christi, I had the privilege of receiving the greatest gift imaginable—the Body and Blood of Christ in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

As we settle into the slower pace and joys of summer, I encourage you and your family to continue making Sunday Mass a priority. Amid vacations, camps, and summer activities, may we never lose our anticipation for encountering Jesus in the Eucharist. Each Sunday is an opportunity to receive His love, His grace, and His presence through the Most Blessed Sacrament.

May your summer be filled with rest, joy, and many opportunities to draw closer to Christ.

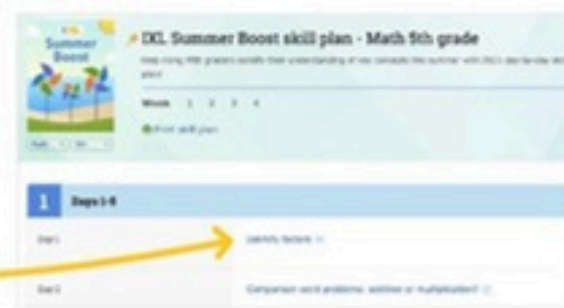

### In-the-moment support

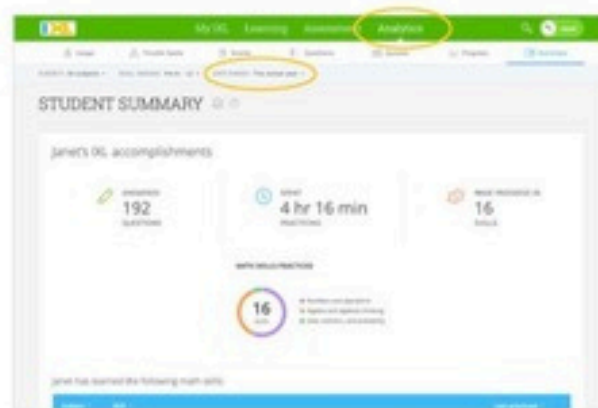

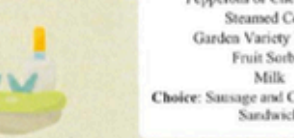
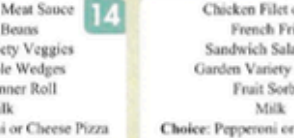

## OFFICE OF CHILD PROTECTION

According to the Safe Environment Policy promulgated by the Diocese of Baton Rouge, **all parish and school ministry volunteers/chaperones must complete a mandatory background check and child protection training.** Child Protection credentials allow the holder of these credentials the opportunity to chaperone/volunteer. All credentialed adults must abide by the sign-up and confirmation process for each event.

## PARENTS' COMMITMENT TO CHURCH & SCHOOL

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Enrollment and/or continued enrollment at Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School requires a commitment to ALL of the following:

- **Prayer and Mass** – Families must commit to daily prayer at home. Catholic families must attend weekly, Sunday, Mass on Holy Days of Obligation. Non-Catholic families must attend Sunday services at their home church.
- **Service** – Twenty (20) hours of Time and Talent given to the school and/or Church each year. Hours must be completed between January 1 and December 31 *to receive the in-parish tuition rate*. These hours are reviewed each year. Definition of an hour of Time and Talent: an actual hour of volunteer work or donation purchases of \$10
- **Weekly Church Offering** – A minimum amount of \$325 will be donated to the Church to support the stewardship program as an Identified Offertory Giver (IOG). Those donations must be made through weekly use of MBS church envelopes, automatic church deductions, or online giving through the church website. Catholic church members who meet the *IOG requirement will receive the in-parish tuition*. Donations will be verified by December 15 unless otherwise authorized by the Pastor/Principal. Any offerings thereafter will count towards the following year.

Catholic families meeting these requirements will receive the in-parish tuition rate. Any families who have not met the stewardship commitment requirements will receive either the Catholic Out-of-Parish tuition or Non-Catholic rates.

### New Students

Time and Talent hours are prorated (10 hours) for new students. New Catholic families must also meet the IOG requirement of \$325.00 to receive in-parish tuition the following school year.

**Go to Family > Family Home. You will see "Service Hours" in the middle of the screen. Click "add" to add the hours. You must type in a description. Select "type a custom value," and then type your description.**

All Boys & Girls, 3 rd grade through 8 th grade must have a physical evaluation to participate in sports. One form covers all sports, and is valid for the 2026-27 school year. Even if you are participating in the spring of 2027, you can get this on August 5. We use the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA) form, and we have it electronically. You are welcome to use your own physician (and need to use our form) if that is your choice, however, we offer this as an option.

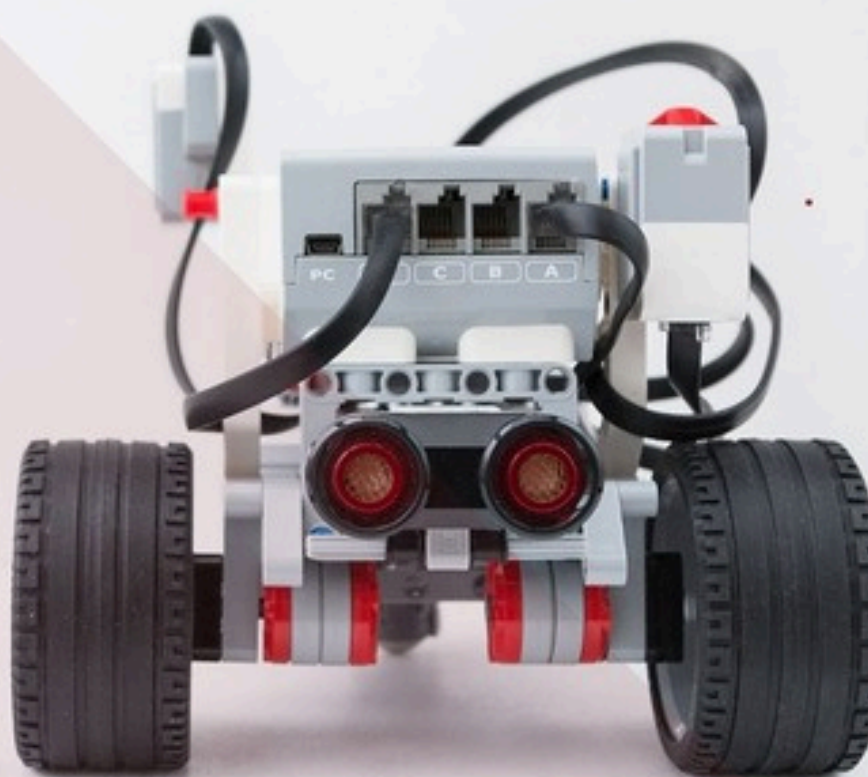

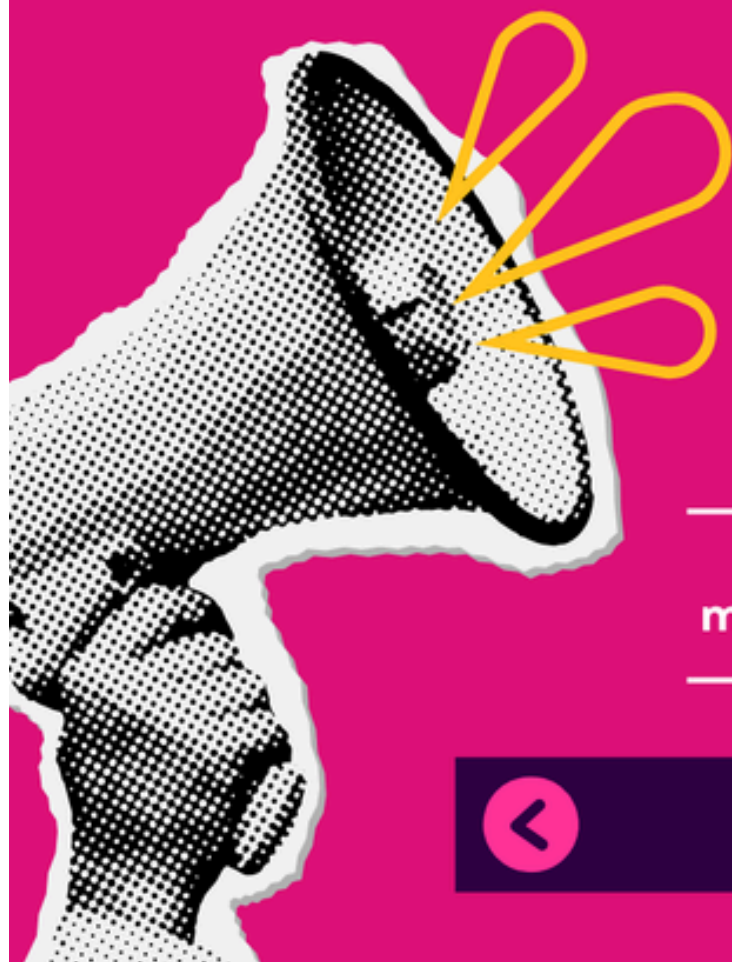
