In the spring of 2026, as part of the LUMEN Accreditation process, Most Blessed Sacrament School began developing Strategic Plan 2031: Rooted in Purpose and Faith, building upon the foundation of our previous strategic plan, Vision for Our Future.

A Strategic Planning Committee was formed to guide the process and gather input from our MBS community. Stakeholders were invited to reflect on our school's past, present, and future through an online questionnaire and three focus group opportunities held at various times to encourage participation.
