STATEMENT OF CLAIM

This is a notice pursuant to Indiana code section 34-13-3.5-1, et seq. on behalf of
a Minor at the time of injury, by her parents,
suffered as a result of intentional, willful, malicious, and/or negligent acts or omissions of Mooresville
Consolidated School Corporation, North Madison Elementary School, and their administration
These events are believed to have taken place at North Madison Elementary School on or about April
14, 2025. Specifically, was harassed, inappropriately touched, and intimidated, by her art
teacher, Mr. James Buchler. Art is a required class at NMES and the inappropriate touching occurred
during art class. A few days later, the parents of were made aware of the incident
in which Mr. James Buchler touched their daughter inappropriately. At the time of the incident, the
school had already received several reports and/or notices that Mr. Buchler had inappropriately
touched other kids. Notwithstanding their prior knowledge, the school did nothing to remove Mr.
Buchler from his position, resulting in being assaulted by Mr. Buchler. As a result of the
foregoing conduct, and her parents had to make the decision to enroll in
another school. has experienced pain and suffering, physical, mental and emotional
trauma, loss of enjoyment of life, medical expenses, counseling expenses, and other damages.
