NOTE FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

Challenge Partners is a practitioner-led charity focused on supporting effective collaboration in the education sector. We have been part of their Quality Assurance Reviews for the past four years with staff visiting other schools to form visiting reviewer teams and this week we hosted our fourth external team to Dulwich Hamlet.

The experience is a real privilege: two teams of professionals combine to run a review of school practice which is both supportive and challenging, inspiring reflection and growth.

We were very pleased with our review team who were all highly-skilled and knowledgeable leaders in education and they were, likewise, impressed by our community. They commented on a wide range of positives and the full review will be shared in due course. Some of the highlights were the polite and welcoming nature of the children, the calm and ordered behaviour in classes, the ambition and challenge of our curriculum and leaders and the quality of our staff team across the board.

It is Challenge Partner's mission to leave us in a better place than when they arrived and so we are left with several 'Even Better Ifs' which will form part of our School Development Priorities as we look forward. Some of the EBIs were items which we had already identified but the really valuable ones are those which our visiting reviewers spotted with fresh perspectives allowing analysis from an external viewpoint.

For their part, all the reviewers spoke of the practices and ideas they will bring back to their own schools. Though, naturally, we refused them permission to take any of our wonderful staff with them.
