NOTE FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

We are now well and truly up and running for the year and your children are continuing to work hard on their learning in school.

On behalf of the teachers, I am now asking parents and carers to support us in establishing and maintaining expectations of homework.

We understand that families have vastly different capacities, approaches and attitudes to this topic, but we also know that home-learning can support accelerated progress as well as foster independence and self-discipline.

All children are expected to read daily and record in their reading records a minimum of three entries per week. This should include all children reading aloud to adults at times.

Doodle maths is a 5-minute daily activity and children need to get in and stay in the 'green zone'. This can be done easily and quickly on a mobile app. Year 6 will also be set 'assignments' linked to their topic which mimics the practice in many secondary schools, although at a lower intensity.

We need your help to learn times tables and spellings. Actually, we are seeking 'overlearning'. This means continuing to recall facts once we know them so that the act of remembering becomes so quick it feels automatic.

Spelling homework is set weekly and quizzing or flashcards at home can support this learning. Times tables can be supported through Times Tables Rock Stars, Doodle Tables or flashcards and quizzes. Y3 have a staggered start to homelearning.


