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Cookie Policy – IFPL

1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy ("Policy") explains how Infina Finance Private Limited ("IFPL", "we", "us", or "our") uses cookies and similar technologies when you visit or interact with our website located at <https://www.infina.co.in/> ("Website").

Cookies help us improve our Website's performance, enhance user experience, and analyse traffic patterns. This Policy provides detailed information about the types of cookies we use, their purposes, your rights regarding their use, and how you can manage your preferences or withdraw consent.

To the extent that information collected through cookies and similar technologies constitutes personal data under applicable law, including the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, IFPL processes such information in accordance with this Cookie Policy, our Privacy Policy, and applicable laws.

2. What are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that a website places on your device when you visit it. These files store information about your browsing activities and preferences, enabling features such as secure logins, personalised settings, and analytical insights.

In addition to cookies, we may deploy similar technologies such as web beacons or pixel tags in limited circumstances. However, the primary technologies utilised on our Website are cookies and local Storage-based authentication mechanisms, as described in this Policy.

3. How IFPL Uses Cookies

IFPL uses cookies and similar technologies to:

- Enable core site functionality (e.g., secure sessions, bot protection, and security controls);
- Understand user behaviour through analytics and usage statistics; and
- Optimise site performance and measure engagement.

These technologies enable us to understand how users navigate our Website and interact with its features, allowing us to make informed decisions to improve our services.

We engage third-party service providers, such as Google Analytics and Cloudflare, to analyse website usage and provide security services on our behalf. These third parties may collect aggregated data about Website visits. Such tracking cookies are only activated upon receiving explicit user consent, except where strictly necessary for security purposes.

Our use of cookies is categorised into different types as elaborated in the 'Types of Cookies We Use' section below.

We ensure that personal information collected via cookies is processed with user consent. Users are provided with clear options to manage their cookie preferences and may opt in or out of specific categories of cookies at any time. Our systems maintain a record of the cookie categories authorised by each user to ensure adherence to their stated preferences.

First-party cookies and technologies are those set directly by IFPL when you visit or interact with our Website and platform. For our Website, authentication is handled via localStorage and JWT Bearer headers. Because these originate from the domain you are actively visiting, they help us provide a consistent, secure, and reliable experience across your interactions with our platform.

Third-party cookies are set by domains other than IFPL — typically through integrations with external service providers such as analytics platforms (e.g., Google Analytics) and security services (e.g., Cloudflare). These cookies are used to:

- Analyse user engagement and website usage statistics;
- Measure site performance and track user interactions; and
- Provide bot protection, traffic management, and security controls.

IFPL only deploys third-party cookies **after obtaining your explicit consent**, in accordance with applicable laws, except for strictly necessary security cookies (such as those set by Cloudflare). You are always given the choice to accept, reject, or manage the use of non-essential cookies through the cookie banner when you visit the Website, our cookie preference settings or your browser configuration.

4. Types of Cookies We Use

A. Strictly Necessary / Security Cookies

These cookies and technologies are essential for the Website and platform to function properly. They enable basic features such as secure sessions, bot protection, traffic management, rate limiting, and security controls. These are required to deliver the requested service or resource. If these cookies are not enabled, the functionality and security of our Website may be impacted. The strictly necessary cookies that we deploy are listed below.

Cookie Key	Domain	Description
_cfuvid	infina.co.in (Cloudflare)	Bot protection, traffic management, rate limiting, and security controls. This is a third-party cookie set by Cloudflare. Retention: Session-based. Traffic/security information is shared with Cloudflare.

B. Analytics Cookies (Third-Party)

These cookies help us understand how users interact with the Website by collecting information on user visits, page performance, and usage statistics. The information collected is used to improve

functionality and user experience. These cookies are set by Google Analytics and help us measure website traffic, understand user behaviour, and track interactions for our GA4 property. Analytics data is transmitted to Google Analytics. All Analytics Cookies are activated only after obtaining your consent. If you choose to disable or disallow these cookies, we may not be able to monitor and improve the performance of our Website effectively.

_ga	infina.co.in (Google Analytics)	Distinguishes unique users by assigning a randomly generated number and generates website usage statistics. Retention: Approximately 2 years. Analytics data is transmitted to Google Analytics.
_ga_ZCNWJ76FCQ	infina.co.in (Google Analytics)	Maintains session information and tracks user interactions for the GA4 property. Retention: Approximately 2 years. Analytics and event data is transmitted to Google Analytics.

- Webflow – Website hosting and CMS; and
- Google Fonts – Web font delivery (limited technical request data only).

You have the right to accept or decline cookies when visiting our Website. You may also withdraw your consent at any time by changing your browser settings or by using our cookie management tool. Below are guides to managing cookies in popular browsers:
