




# Submitting a critical illness insurance claim

### Personal information

- Group plan number and member ID
- Name and address
- Phone number and email address
- Birth date
- Dependent information, if applicable
- Bank routing and account number for direct deposit

### Medical

- Pathology report, if applicable
- Diagnostic test results
- Medical records including diagnosis, progress notes, test results, admission or discharge summaries, and operative reports
