What We're Collecting

We're focusing on warm winter clothing for kids and adults (men and women) — anything that helps someone stay warm outdoors.

Suggested items include:

- Winter coats and jackets
- Sweatshirts and sweatpants
- · Hats, scarves, mittens, and gloves
- Warm socks and winter boots

Blessing Bags

In addition to clothing, we're assembling Blessing Bags that can be handed out to people in need.

These 2-gallon bags will include:

- · Socks, gloves, and hand/foot warmers
- Bottled water and snacks
- Small hygiene items
- · Any other small comfort items we can fit

We'll also be vacuum-sealing coats to keep in cars — ready to share when you see someone walking without something warm to wear.
