The City of Gary Community Development Department announces the First Public Hearing for the development of the 2026–2030 Consolidated Action Plan.

In accordance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requirements under 24 CFR Part 91, this hearing is being held at the beginning of the planning process to obtain public input on the housing and community development needs of the City of Gary. The information gathered will help establish priorities for the use of federal funds received through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG), and HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME).

The purpose of this hearing is to:

- Identify housing, homelessness, and community development needs
- Gather input from residents, stakeholders, and community partners
- Help guide the development of funding priorities for the upcoming Consolidated Plan

All residents, especially low- and moderate-income households, are encouraged to attend and provide feedback on community needs and priorities.
