Membership Acknowledgement Plan (M.A.P.) #ForeverFriendships

The Eastern Area of The Links, Incorporated Membership Acknowledgement Plan (M.A.P.) is designed to serve as a road map to assist chapter Vice Presidents and the membership committee in enhancing /creating meaningful friendship opportunities among chapter members that are actionable and promote purposeful behaviors. In addition, to recognizing all chapter members who display the true meaning of friendship.

The mission of The Links, Incorporated is friends transforming communities through service. The Eastern Area Vice Director will acknowledge the M.A.P. award recipients. In the even years, M.A.P. award recipients will be recognized at an-Eastern Area Leadership Summit. In the odd years, M.A.P. award recipients will be recognized at the Eastern Area Conference. All Eastern Area Chapters Vice Presidents are encouraged to participate by using the M.A.P. design.

Meaningful Activities:

- **Super Sister** A Link Sister who has exhibited supportive and encouraging behavior toward another Link Sister as observed by a chapter member and reported to the chapter President or Vice President. The chapter member (observer) will provide written documentation (250 words limit) describing the sisterly act. The Super Sister will be acknowledged during the Vice President's report at a chapter meeting. Vice Presidents should encourage monthly submissions.
- **Green Circle Moment** Vice Presidents are encouraged to provide an opportunity annually to address difficult topics as determined by the chapter. Friendships are enhanced when difficult topics are addressed in a timely manner.

Membership Deliverables:

• **Core Values** - The Code of Ethics is built upon a set of core values rooted within our organization's history and philosophy and is consistent with the evolution of our organization. Each month, the Eastern Area Vice Director will select a core value from the 10 core values established in 1992. It is an expectation that each member will adhere to these core values. The Core values are designed to remind all members of how they should interact and behave toward one another. The Chapter Vice President and the membership committee, along with the Ethics and Standards Chair, will determine a creative way to spotlight and remind chapter members of the monthly core value.

- Managing Your Own Membership (M.Y.O.M.): Each member is ultimately responsible for her own membership. She is responsible for meeting all of the requirements of membership, as outlined in our governing documents. The chapter leadership will assist members with managing their membership.
- **Pop-up Friendship Activities*** An event or activity that is a spontaneous gettogether of chapter members and/or neighboring chapters. The Membership Committee will collaborate with its members to create these pop-up friendship activities.
- **Member Satisfaction Assessment -** The Vice President and Membership Committee will conduct an annual member satisfaction assessment to determine each member's satisfaction with their chapter and personal sense of belonging.

Purposeful Activities:

- **Evaluations** The Membership Committee will conduct post-evaluations to determine the effectiveness of chapter initiatives.

 It is essential that all members provide input on the implemented initiatives.
- Link Sisters Serving with Link Sisters Moment* a Link Sister serving with another Link Sister in a community activity that does <u>not</u> involve Link programming or partnerships. These moments should be captured and reported to the Vice President in the M.A.P. report. Service hours will not be given for these moments.
- **Social Media Campaign** To promote the activities of the Eastern Area on social media platforms by using hashtags; for example-#ElevateandEmpower, #ForeverFriendships, #EALinks.
- Platinum & Alumna Month
 - a. The President shall appoint the Platinum & Alumna Chair, who is a member of the membership Committee.
 - b. The Vice President and Membership Committee will plan a celebration in honor of its Platinum and Alumna members during March.
 - c. The Platinum and Alumna Affairs chapter chair will provide "Emerald Sage" moments at Chapter Meetings.
 - d. The Platinum and Alumna Affairs chair will provide quarterly "Emerald Sage" articles for submission to the Eastern Area Newsletter.
- Nex-Gen Chair (age 21-45) The President shall appoint the Nex-Gen Chair, who is a member of the membership Committee. The Nex-Gen Chair will engage Nex-Gen members to build a more inclusive chapter, which includes intergenerational activities relevant and supportive of its Nex-Gen members.

Eligibility Criteria

Individual Member Recognition:

The chapter Vice President will identify one Super Sister nominee and provide written documentation (250 words limit) for the program year.

Chapter Recognition:

The award recognition will be determined by a point system for the M.A.P applications. The chapters with the three highest number of points achieved will receive recognition.

Chapter Vice President & Membership Committee Recognition:

The chapter Vice President and the Membership Committee members of the first, second, and third place winning chapters will be recognized for their commitment and efforts to promoting friendship.
