1. The website <https://ari10.com> (hereinafter: the “Website”) uses cookies. Below you will find information about what cookies are, what types of cookies are used, and for what purposes they are applied.
2. Cookies are small text files stored on your end device when you use the Website. They serve, among other things, statistical purposes, facilitate the functioning of the Website, allow the analysis of user activity, and help adapt the Website’s operation to the User’s remembered preferences. Cookies may be placed by the Website (first-party cookies) or by third parties (third-party cookies).
3. The entity placing cookies on your end device and accessing them is the Website administrator (Controller) – Bitcan sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Poznań (Podlaska 15 St., 60-623 Poznań), entered in the Register of Entrepreneurs under KRS number 0000808472, NIP: 6292495068, REGON: 384619443, share capital: PLN 10,500.
4. Cookies are used to ensure the proper functioning of the Website, to tailor it to the User’s preferences, and for analytical and marketing purposes (if you have given your consent to such cookies).
5. Depending on their purpose, we use the following categories of cookies:

a) Necessary cookies – enable the use of essential functions of the Website, such as navigation or access to secure areas. These cookies are installed automatically and do not require the User’s consent.

b) Preference cookies – allow the Website to remember choices made by the User, such as preferred language.

- o *pll_language* – used to remember the visitor’s preferred language and, if possible, to automatically set the Website’s language version accordingly.

c) Third-party cookies – enable the use of external features, such as embedded multimedia content:

- o *Social media cookies* – allow sharing content via social networks (e.g., YouTube). To use these features, you must accept the terms of the respective provider, including their cookies policy. If consent is not given, these cookies will not be installed.

d) Analytical cookies (e.g., Google Analytics) – the Website uses the Google Analytics tool to analyze how Users interact with the Website. The data collected via Google Analytics is anonymous and used solely for statistical purposes and to improve the Website’s performance. The use of Google Analytics occurs only after obtaining your consent for the installation of analytical cookies.

6. The storage period for cookies varies depending on their type. Some are deleted after the browser session ends (session cookies), while others may be stored on the User's device for a specific period or until manually deleted (persistent cookies).
7. **Managing cookies** – The User may change cookie settings at any time in their web browser. Restricting the use of cookies may, however, affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.
8. **Cookie consent** – Upon visiting the Website, a banner appears informing about the use of cookies. The User may consent to all cookies ("Accept all") or make individual choices via the "Settings" option. Necessary cookies are installed automatically.
9. Services provided by third parties are beyond our control. These parties may change their terms of service, privacy policies, and cookies policies at any time.
10. **Changes to the Cookies Policy** – This Cookies Policy may be updated from time to time, particularly in the event of changes in legislation, supervisory authority guidelines, or technological and functional changes to the Website. In the case of significant changes, Users will be informed upon their next visit to the Website, via a cookie banner or other appropriate method. We recommend reviewing this Policy regularly to stay informed of any updates.
