

Condensed version of Le Grand Continental

Participatory work In situ 10 minutes With 50 amateur dancers

Any municipality can offer its residents the opportunity to experience a condensed version of the gigantic contemporary line dance created in 2009, <u>Le Grand Continental</u>.

Over the course of 8 rehearsals, 50 participants learn a ten-minute portion of the choreography. In addition to performing a segment of the popular show, they also collaborate with Sylvain Émard on a short original dance that crowns the public presentation of their work.
