Request for Quotation –Ref No. S-G-19 For Procurement of Two (2) Servers

- 1. The Ministry of Health (MOH), with assistance from the Asian Development Bank (ADB), has approved the allocation of funds under the project *Systems Strengthening for Effective Coverage of New Vaccines in the Pacific (Samoa)*. These funds will be used to procure much-needed servers for the Expanded Programme on Immunization (EPI). 2. Interested eligible bidders may obtain further information and inspect the bidding documents from the MOH Finance and Procurement Division from Monday to Friday from 9.00 am to 4.00 pm local time. Additional details are provided in the Bidding Documents. The new servers are essential to strengthen the Ministry's data management systems, enhance the reliability and security of health information, and improve the overall efficiency of immunization programme operations.

- 3. Bids must be delivered to the Secretary, Tenders Board, 4th Floor, Central Bank of Samoa, Beach Road, Apia, Samoa in sealed envelopes by Monday November 24th, 2025 by 11.00 am local time and must be clearly marked "Procurement for Two Servers".
- 4. Bids will be opened and closed by the Tenders Board on Monday November 24th, 2025 at 11:00am at the venue indicated in (3) above, in the presence of the Bidders or Bidders' representatives who choose to attend. Late bids will be rejected.
