3. Certificate Of Pharmaceutical Product (COPP): Is it mandatory to submit along with quote please confirm?
 - **This is Mandatory.**
4. Certificate Of Analysis (COA): Is it mandatory to submit along with quote please confirm?
 - **This is Mandatory.**
5. Is Attached format document we need to submit along with Annex A & Annex B please confirm?
 - **No, completing the blank columns in Annexures A and B is sufficient to fulfill this section of the Price Schedules and requirements.**

7. In the Annexure A – Schedule mode of requirements: The PREFERRED MODE OF TRANSPORT mentioned is Air Freight for all the products. Is this mandatory to BID our products in CIF – Air Freight only or we can BID in CIF- Sea Freight also?
 - **Airfreight mode of transport is preferred for these medicines, as they require proper packaging and cold chain delivery.**
