JUNE 2026 Retail Fuel Prices

The Minister of Finance has advised that the following changes in retail petroleum product prices, inclusive of VAGST, will apply from 1st June 2026.

- Petrol: increase by 47.6 sene per litre, from \$3.51 to \$3.99
- Diesel: increase by 80.4 sene per litre, from \$4.50 to \$5.31
- Kerosene: increase by 96.9 sene per litre, from \$4.05 to \$5.02

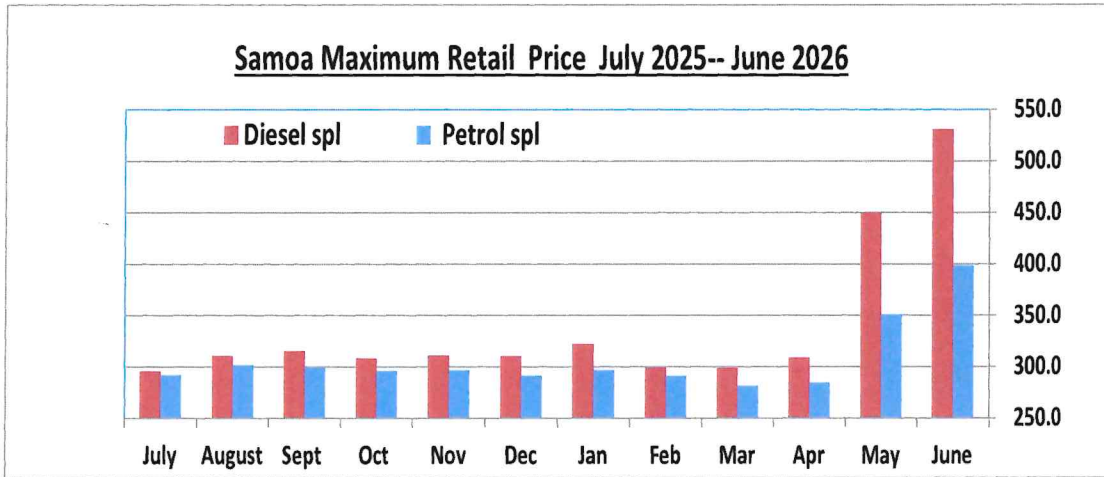
As the USA/Iran conflict enters its 14th week, both crude and refined product prices remain volatile. Reports that the US and Iran were close to reaching a deal to reopen the Strait of Hormuz have not materialised, and worldwide crude oil supply remains constrained.

The price increases in May and this month now reflect the ongoing impact of the USA/Iran conflict on refined product prices.

On the supply side, Government continues to work with our supplier, ExxonMobil. Further cargoes are scheduled to arrive this week and in early July.
