Contract Title: *Supply and install six (6) new land- based Automatic Weather System (AWS)*

The *Independent State of Samoa* has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the *PREPARE*, and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for *Supply and install 6 new land-based AWS*. This contract will be jointly financed by Systematic Observations Financing Facility (SOFF). Bidding process will be governed by the World Bank and the Government of Samoa's rules and procedures.

The *Ministry of Natural, Resources and Environment (MNRE)* now invite sealed bids from eligible bidders for the goods and service required.

The bidder must have proven experience in the supply, installation and commissioning of hydrometeorological AWS and demonstrate at least three internationally recognised successful AWS projects. The equipment must comply with relevant WMO standards and international requirements, including applicable calibration requirements.

Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Procurement procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers, dated September 2025* ("the Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the

Procurement Guidelines.
