

## BECOMING A CITYSERVEX PARTNER SITE - BEYOND THE OVERVIEW

### Exploring a Partnership with CityServeX

You've read the overview, and you're interested in learning more about what it would take to partner with **CityServeX** and become a **Partner Site**.

We're so glad you're curious — and we welcome the opportunity to share more.

First, a little context: **CityServeX** is currently in a pilot phase, working alongside a select group of **Partner Sites** to build out the processes and procedures that accompany the tools and training we provide. These organizations and faith communities are already walking with people — helping them find what they need and giving them hope. We meet with our **Partner Sites** weekly to offer coaching, support, and mutual feedback on what's working and what's needed. Together, we're refining a volunteer model of **Resource Coordination** that can meet a community need that is too often overlooked — or at best, underserved.

If your organization is passionate about community engagement, wants to help people flourish, and has a vision for a brighter future, a **CityServeX** partnership for **Resource Coordination** could be exactly the right fit.

### What Partnership Requires

- **Nonprofit status.** **Partner Sites** must be registered as a 501(c)(3) or recognized as a nonprofit, which includes faith communities.
- **Designated leadership.** **Partner Sites** must appoint or hire someone to oversee the **Resource Coordination** program. This can be a full-time or part-time role, depending on your program's design.
- **Clear governance.** Who is accountable for the program's effectiveness? Who is responsible for upholding the partnership agreement? These questions need clear answers before we move forward.



- **Budgetary planning.** CityServeX's model is built on volunteerism, but costs may include a program leader's salary and, after the initial pilot phase, software expenses. **Partner Sites** are responsible for developing and sustaining their own budget for these items.

## Questions Worth Sitting With

Before going further, we'd invite you to ask yourself a few honest questions:

**"Why us?" Resource Coordination** takes commitment, planning, and genuine passion for helping people move their lives forward. Does this work align with your organization's mission and values? This is compassion work — are you ready to make it a priority?

**"Is this the right time?"** You may have the passion and the willingness, but can you act on it *now*? A partnership with CityServeX means that within 3–6 months of signing a Partnership Agreement, you could be launching the service of **Resource Coordination** in your community. Does that timeline fit where you are today?
