Founded in 1982, A Wish Come True is the oldest Wish granting organization in Rhode Island, Central and Southeastern Massacusetts, and Eastern Connecticut, serving up to 40 wishes a year. In addition to granting Wishes, A Wish Come True (AWCT) provides on-going support to the children's families. This includes the Wish of Wellness, emergency funding, hosting local events, game tickets, in-kind donations, and holiday support. A Wish Come True is not associated with any national company and all funding goes directly to supporting local children and their families.

Granting Wishes to Children 3-18

How do I refer a child to A Wish Come True, Inc.?

As part of our Wish program, we accept all referrals of a child living in Rhode Island, Central and Southeastern Massachusetts and Eastern Connecticut with a lifethreatening illness. To refer a child, you may email kelly@awishcometrue.org, or contact us at 401-781-9199, and we will do the rest.

Does a child's condition have to be terminal to qualify for a Wish?

No, any child with a life-threatening illness, as determined by the child's physician, is medically qualified. The AWCT staff follows guidelines and works closely with the Wish Child's physician to determine the safest and most appropriate way to grant the child's Wish.

What is the most requested Wish?

The most requested Wish is a trip to our partner at Give Kids the World in Florida, which includes tickets to Disney World, Universal, and SeaWorld. Other popular Wishes include shopping sprees, computers, cruises, and travel outside of Florida. These are just a few examples of the over 1,900 Wishes we have granted during the last 43 years.

Are you associated with a national Wish organization?

No, A Wish Come True is not associated with any national organization. We are a local Wish granting agency and we are the only ones providing emergency funding, resources, and the Wish of Wellness for the entire family.



FAQS

How much does a Wish cost?

The average cost of granting a Wish is between \$5,000 and \$7,000. This varies depending on the Wish, size of the family, and if there are any special medical needs to consider.

Does the family have to pay for the Wish?

No, all Wish expenses are fully covered by A Wish Come True, including all travel accommodations and spending money. This is a time for you to relax.

Does the family have to meet income qualifications before a child can receive a Wish?

No, the family's income does not determine whether a child is eligible to receive a Wish.

The Wish of Wellness for Families!

Life is stressful, especially when you are caring for a child (or multiple children) with a life-threatening illness. A Wish Come True recognizes that support needs to look different for each family and are constantly working to develop a holistic approach that serves their unique community. Some of these services include the following:

- Emergency Financial Assistance through the Meghan K. Duffy Hardship Fund.
- Care Packages during medical crisis including gifts for the children and parents, gas cards, parking pass, meals, and groceries.
- Crafts and activities where families will unwind, have some fun together... and be encouraged to share a talent or skill.
- Quarterly gatherings such as a Summer Fun Day, Trunk-or-Treat and more will remind our families that there is a reason to celebrate and that our community is strong and resilient.
- Nap's Nook Playroom and Relaxation Room featuring movies, games and activities for the kids and a massage chair with relaxing sounds and dim lights for the parents.
