



The Elmhurst Boys are excited to announce our 11th annual charity golf tournament. The tournament will take place at Richmond Country Club on Saturday June 13, 2026.

Our past 10 tournaments have raised over \$190,000, which we have donated to many local charities and families in need.

We've had as many as 148 golfers and 60 additional lunch participants at past events, providing maximum exposure for your sponsorship.

Here are the sponsorship opportunities. And we are open to suggestions from our sponsors as well! Note that for all levels of sponsors, you may choose to add your own SWAG items to the golfer gift bags, as approved by the Elmhurst Boys and provided by you at least one week prior to the tournament.

**\$2,500 – Tournament Sponsor:**
