Site visits may be **scheduled** and are designed to:

- Observe teaching and learning in practice
- Review assessment delivery, marking, and moderation processes
- Meet academic staff, programme leads, and senior management
- Inspect teaching facilities, learning resources, and learner-support systems
- Confirm ongoing alignment with agreed academic and quality standards

Site visits form a **key pillar of quality assurance**, supporting transparency, continuous improvement, and confidence in programmes delivered under UK endorsement. Findings from

visits inform ongoing academic oversight and, where appropriate, recommendations for enhancement.

Partner FAQ

Q: Who delivers the programme?

A: The programme is delivered by the overseas partner institute in line with the agreed academic and quality framework.

Q: Who issues the certificate?

A: Certificates are issued by Excel College, confirming successful completion of a UK-endorsed programme.

Q: Is this a UK degree or regulated qualification?

A: No. Certificates issued under this model are UK-issued but non-regulated, intended for academic recognition and professional development purposes.

Q: Can programmes be adapted to local markets?

A: Yes. Content, delivery mode, and scheduling can be adapted, subject to academic review and approval by the Excel College.

Q: What learner groups is this suitable for?

A: This model works well for young adult, mature learners, working professionals, executive cohorts, and corporate training.

Q: Can we market the programme as UK-endorsed?

A: Yes. Approved partners may use wording such as “Delivered by [Partner Institute] with academic endorsement from Excel College – UK” and “UK-endorsed programme with certificate issued by a UK college”. Branding guidance is provided during onboarding.

Q: How long does endorsement last?

A: Endorsement is granted for a defined period – normally 2 years - and is subject to periodic academic review and renewal.
