ENCOURAGING WORDS
<p><b>Our “Bucket List”</b></p> <p>Over the last several years, people have started making lists of the things they want to be sure they accomplish before they die. The term used for these lists is “bucket list.” This term is probably used because it contains the goals a person plans to reach before they “kick the bucket.”</p> <p>Let’s take this phrase and apply it to some of the characters mentioned throughout the Bible.</p> <p><b>David had a “bucket list.”</b> Because of the book of Psalms, we know so much about the heart of this godly man. By reading the psalms, we can change our hearts to be like the heart of the man who had a heart like God. It may seem strange, but David only had one item on his “bucket list.” <i>“One thing I ask from the Lord, this only do I seek: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze on the beauty of the Lord and to seek Him in His temple.” (Psa. 27:4)</i></p> <p><b>Paul had a “bucket list.”</b> Paul wrote half of the books of the New Testament and even after all of that had accomplished, He said, <i>“Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself yet to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead, <sup>14</sup>I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.” (Phil. 3:13-14)</i> He wanted one thing above everything and that was to reach the prize awaiting those who respond to the call of the Lord.</p> <p><b>Do you have a “bucket list”?</b> A bucket list may help you to keep focused and give you goals to drive you to do more in your life. However, just make sure that you have something on your list which is like that <b>one thing</b> both David and Paul wanted to accomplish and had on their list. “When we’ve been there ten thousand years” you will be thankful for that “One Thing” that was at the top of your list!</p> <p>R.
