# **Pot Stirring!**

Have you ever noticed that some folks just like to stir up trouble! Unfortunately, stirring up trouble is not limited to an activity with a bee hive. Husbands, wives, children and friends can also have a talent for stirring stuff up! Take a few minutes and consider some "stirring" passages, especially from the wisdom of Proverbs.

"A harsh word stirs up anger" (Prov. 15:1). Our words, and the tone with which they are spoken, can have a very harmful impact on others. Perhaps that is why James says, "The tongue is a fire" (3:6). Have you ever said something that, intentionally or unintentionally, stirred up a fire of anger? "Hatred stirs up strife" (Prov. 10:12). Hatred is such a strong emotion and can cause us to say and do things that, perhaps, we would not normally
