How's My Driving?!

Have you seen those signs on the backs of commercial trucks and vans? They say something like, "How's My Driving?" And there is a phone number to call and a truck/van number to report about "their driving."

Why are these signs on the backs of the trucks and vans? The reason is that these trucks and vans represent the company that is plastered all over the sides and back of the vehicle. More specifically, the driver of the truck/van, whoever he is, is a representative of that company and their product. So, whether it's a restaurant (like McDonald's) or a store (like Walmart or Target), there is an immediate connection made between how the truck (i.e., driver) is behaving on the road and whether an individual may want to have anything to do with that company.

What does that have to do with us? Don't worry, this has nothing to do with your driving. Well, not really. The truth is that this concept is nothing new. God has been utilizing it for years.

As a Christian, you may not realize that you have a sign on you that says, "How's My Living?" There are people who are watching you—how you live, how you talk, how you behave, how you treat others, etc. And, just as people make a connection between the guy driving the Coke truck and the Coca-Cola company itself, people are making a connection between you (as a Christian) and the One that you are representing with that name—CHRIST!

Consider carefully this well-known verse. *"Let your light so shine before men that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."* **(Matt. 5:16)**

So, how's your "driving"? What does your "driving" say about the One that you represent—Christ? If there was a phone number for people to call God, what would they say about you? Of course, we're not talking about actual driving but about actual living and the eternal impact it has on others!
