ENCOURAGING WORDS

What the Bible IS NOT....and what the Bible IS!

You can pick up a novel to read. You can pick up a bedtime story book. You can pick up a self-help book. You can pick up a biography. There are several different kinds of books that you can read today, but when you pick up your Bible, there is nothing else like it! What sets it apart from all other books today?

First, consider what the Bible is **NOT**. Did you know that Scripture repeatedly informs its readers what they are NOT reading? Consider each of these statements carefully.

- The Bible is “**not** the wisdom of this age, **nor** of the rulers of this age.” (1 Cor. 2:6)
- The Bible is **not** the “word of men.” (1 Thess. 2:13)
- The Bible is “**not** in words taught by human wisdom. (1 Cor. 2:12-13)
- The Bible is “**not** according to man.” (Gal. 1:11)
- The Bible is “**not** to please man.” (1 Thess. 2:4)

Think about that. If you pick up the Bible, thinking that it is just like any other book that you can find in a library, you are continually reminded that this book is **not** from man and does not contain the wisdom of **man**. So what is it?

Secondly, after considering what the Bible says that it is not, we must investigate what the Bible **IS**. The Bible informs us clearly of its divine origin.

- The Bible **is** “God breathed.” (2 Tim. 3:16)
- The Bible **is** “the wisdom of God.” (1 Cor. 2:7)
- The Bible **is** “the Lord’s command.” (1 Cor. 14:37)
- The Bible **is** “the word of truth.” (2 Tim. 2:15)
- The Bible **is** “the word of life.” (Phil. 2:16)

What a glorious book! What a unique book! What a treasured book above all others! As you pick up your Bible and study it, know what it is NOT....and cherish what it IS!
