Mountain Tops and Valleys

Our Spiritual lives are not always characterized by "mountaintop experiences." It was wonderful for Moses to be in the presence of God on Mount Sinai, but eventually he had to leave the mountain and return to the reality of dealing with the Jewish rebellion in worshiping the golden calf.

Elijah experienced this same problem in the contest he had with 450 prophets of Baal on Mount Carmel. The fire from heaven totally consumed the prophet's sacrifice and shortly afterwards there was the slaughter of all the false prophets. Yet, when Elijah descended from that mount, he was so overwhelmed with the sinfulness of Israel, he asked God to take him, for he thought he was the only person in Israel who faithfully served Jehovah.

"Mountaintop experiences" are so wonderful. There are those times when we see great spiritual victories and figuratively are on top of the world. Thank God for "mountaintop experiences."
