ENCOURAGING WORDS

The True Meaning of Life

John penned His gospel account in order to prove to his readers that "*Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God,*" and to elicit a response of faith-filled obedience (**John 20:30-31**). His ultimate desire for his readers was that through "*believing they may have life in His name.*" What an interesting way to say that! "Life" is available to those who believe, but only "in His name." What does that mean?

"**Life**" is tied to believing "**in His name.**" The apostle John wrote of the necessity to "believe **in His name**" (**John 1:12; 2:23; 3:18**). Then we find this wonderful verse in his first epistle, "*These things I have written to you who believe **in the name of the Son of God, that you may know that you have eternal life***" (**1 John 5:13**). Believing "in His name" is essential to secure "life"!

"**Life**" is tied to being baptized "**in His name.**" While some folks today would never tie "life" to "baptism," Scripture makes it abundantly clear that God does. The book of Acts records the command of God to be "*baptized **in the name of Jesus Christ***" (2:38; 10:48), and supplies the examples of those who were. Further New Testament evidence shows that identity with Christ is tied to being "*baptized **in the name of***" Christ (**1 Cor. 1:13**). Being baptized "in His name" is essential to secure "life"!

"**Life**" is tied to doing all things "**in His name.**" Paul wrote to the church at Colosse, "And whatever you do in word or deed, do all **in the name of** the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him" (**Col. 3:17**). In its twin epistle, Paul wrote again, "...giving thanks always for all things to God the Father **in the name of** our Lord Jesus Christ" (**Eph. 5:20**). Doing all things "in His name" is essential to "life"!

There is one Biblical way to secure "life in His name!" Follow His plan and it will be yours!
